

Glenwood Special Meeting – June 4, 2025, 7:00 p.m.

Pursuant to IC 5-14-1.5-5, a special meeting was called by the Glenwood Town Council joint with the Park Board. The meeting was held at the town hall at 217 N. Main Street, Glenwood, IN.

Denny Richardson, Council President, declared a quorum and called the special meeting to order. Other officers besides Denny Richardson present were Jo Temple, Council Vice President; and Mary M. Richardson, Clerk-Treasurer. David Miller, Council Member, was absent. Town Board members present were Dianne Medd, George Stamm, Jack Rummel, and Rosie Rummel. Denny turned the meeting over to Brad Schutte, Schutte Excavating, Inc). Brad was selected by the Rush County Community Foundation to deliver the park upgrades through Lilly Gift VIII funding. David Burkhart, Rush County Community Foundation board member, was also present. David Miller, Council Member, was absent.

Brad provided a preliminary budget and map reflecting park upgrades. There were discussions and changes made to the projected playground. Toddler equipment will be added. The ADA sidewalk will be concrete. Drainage will be added. A shelter will be moved and converted to a shelter/stage.

Brad will provide a revised park layout and cost estimates. If the estimate exceeds the \$240,000 budget, the Council and Park Board will consider what needs to be deleted, deferred, or paid from town funds.

After the final budget is approved by the Town Council, Brad will submit the information to the Foundation. When the Foundation approves the budget, equipment will be ordered. It is estimated that the project will begin in September and completed within two weeks.

No other business was discussed. A motion was made by Jo Temple and seconded by Denny Richardson to adjourn the meeting. Motion was unanimous.
